Control Regulations Concerning Doupion Cocoons, Waste Cocoons, Raw Silk By-Products and Floss Silk. Article 1. Doupion cocoons and waste cocoons referred

to in this Ministerial Ordinance shall include all doupion cocoons and waste cocoons produced by sericulturists, and all doupion cocoons and waste cocoons which have been selected out by raw silk manufacturers. However, waste cocoons unsuitable for reeling shall not be included in this category.

Raw silk by-products shall include the follow-

ing:
1. "Kibiso" (including "noshi-ito");

2. "Bisu";

3. Coocons waste unsuitable for reeling;

"Mayu keba" (blaze);

5. Raw silk waste;

6. Any of the goods mentioned in the preceding items which has undergone processing such as "senjo" (washing) or "seiren" (degumming).

Floss silk shall include all unprocessed floss silk, and products using unprocessed floss silk as raw material or material and designated by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry.

When the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry makes the designation as mentioned in the preceding paragraph, public notice shall be given thereof.

Article 2. The silkworm egg producers, sericulturists, or raw silk manufacturers shall transfer the doupion cocoons, waste cocoons or raw silk waste which have been produced or set aside, to the person designated by the prefectural governor (hereinafter referred to. as "the designated handler"), except in case where the cocoons are to be used for personal purposes, as provided in Article 1 of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry Ordinance No. 12 of 1946, (concerning Measures for Securing Export Raw Silk) and permission has been obtained from the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry under special reasons, or in case where the cocoons are to be transferred to the National Cocoons and Raw Silk By-Products Trade Control Association.

Floss silk manufacturers shall transfer the floss silk produced to the organization designated by the prefectural governor (hereinafter referred to as "the

designated organization").

Article 3. The designated handler shall transfer the doupion cocoons, waste cocoons or raw silk waste which it has obtained by transfer to the National Cocoons and Silk By-Products Trade Control Association.

The designated organization shall transfer the floss silk which it has obtained by transfer, to the Japan Floss Silk Manufacturing and Sales Control

Association.

Article 4. The National Cocoons and Silk By-Products
Trade Control Association or the Japan Floss Silk
Manufacturing and Sales Control Association shall,
in conformity with the plan which has been approved
by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry, distribute silk which it has obtained by transfer.

Article 5. The National Cocoons and Silk By-Products
Trade Control Association or the Japan Floss Silk
Manufacturing and Sales Control Association shall,
by the 20th of each month, report to the Minister of
Agriculture and Forestry the amount of doupion
cocoons, cocoons waste, raw silk by-products or
floss silk which it has obtained by transfer or distributed during the preceding month.

Supplementary Provision:

This Ministerial Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation. However, the provisions of Article 5 shall be enforced as from January 1, 1947.
