CABINET ORDINANCE

Cabinet Ordinance No. 84

December 6, 1946

The procedure concerning the renewal of Pension Certificate issued by the persons as prescribed in the proviso to Art. 2 of Supplementary Provisions of the Imperial Ordinance No. 504 of 1946, and the renewal procedure of the pension which is to be increased in accordance with the provisions of Art. 8 of Supplementary Provisions of the Law No. 36 of the same year, shall be determined as follows:

Prime Minister

Art. 1. The President of the Pensions Bureau of the Cabinet shall make renewal of the Pension Certificate issued by the persons as prescribed in Art. 2 of Supplementary Provisions of the Imperial Ordinance No. 504 of 1946, in accordance with the provisions of Arts. 2 to 5 inclusive.

Art. 2. The person who receives pension by virtue of the pension certificate issued by the official prescribed in the preceding Article, shall submit, through the Foreign Minister, the following papers to the President of the Pensions Bureau:

1. Acknowledgement of Pension Granting (Annexed Form No. 1)
2. Chronological Record during the tenure of office of an official or a person treated as such.
3. Pension Certificate.
4. An extract copy of census-register or certificate as prescribed in Art. 14-(3) of the Census-Register Law for the person who receives pension as official or person treated as such; and a copy of census register for the person who receives pension as bereaved family of those persons.
5. Statement relative to the military service (Annexed Form No. 2) The person who is in circumstances difficult to submit the Pension Certificate, shall submit a paper stating in detail the circumstances together with an official certificate of the Police Office and the like, which may confirm these circumstances.

Art. 3. The President of the Pensions Bureau of the Cabinet shall, after examining the papers prescribed in the preceding Article, issue the Pension Certificate with regard to the pension to be applied to the provisions of paragraph 3 of Supplementary Provisions of the Imperial Ordinance No. 68 of 1946, stating the revised annual amount or notice stating the decided amount of revised pension and with regard to the others, the Pension Certificate stating the annual amount of the former pension, and shall deliver them to the claimants respectively.

Art. 4. The President of the Pensions Bureau of the Cabinet shall, on the delivery of the renewed Pension Certificate or notice announcing the decided pension pursuant to the provisions of the preceding Article, notify the necessary matters for granting pension, to the Director of the Tokyo Savings Branch Office.

Art. 5. With regard to the matters which are not especially provided in the provisions of the preceding four Articles, Regulations of Granting Pensions shall be applied *mutatis mutandis*.

Art. 6. The renewal procedure of the pension which is to be increased in accordance with the provisions of Art. 8 of Supplementary Provisions of the Law No. 36 of 1946 (hereinafter called pension applicable to the Law), and which is decided or is to be decided by the President of the Pensions Bureau of the Cabinet, shall be applied to the provisions of Arts. 7 to 10 inclusive.

Art. 7. The pension applicable to the Law, which is granted by virtue of the Pension Certificate dated before June 30, 1946, shall, without waiting for the application of claimant, be renewed, and the new Pension Certificate showing its renewed annual amount shall be issued.

Art. 8. In respect of the pension applicable to the Law which is to be decided after June 1, 1946, the Pension Certificate stating the renewed annual amount and the former annual amount, shall be issued.

Art. 9. The renewed Pension Certificate prescribed in Art. 7, shall be delivered to the claimant through the Tokyo Savings Branch Office.

The claimant shall sign and seal for receipt the former Pension Certificate, and receive, by exchange, the renewed Pension Certificate.

Art. 10. The provisions of Art. 5. shall be applied *mutatis mutandis*, to the case of the preceding four Articles.

Supplementary Provisions:

The present Cabinet Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

MINISTERIAL ORDINANCE

Ministry for Home Affairs Ordinance No. 52

December 6, 1946

Minister for Home Affairs

OMURA Seiichi

Matters pertaining dissolution etc. of Zaidan Hojin

Musashi Jyutaku Kyokai and others in conformity with the subject concerning the Orders to be issued in consequence of the acceptance of Potsdam Declaration, Imperial Ordinance No. 542, 20th year of Showa (1945) are hereby enacted as follows:

Article 1. Zaidan Hojin Musashi Jyutaku Kyokai (here and hereinafter including all the branches and sub-branches thereof), Zaidan Hojin Josai Kai, Zaidan Hojin Nippon Fukuso Kyokai (here and hereafter including all the branches thereof), Zaidan Hojin Osaka Kosai Kyokai, Zaidan Hojin Kinjo Ikuei Kai, Zaidan Hojin Keijin Kai and Zentsuji Sewakumiai shall be dissolved.

Article 2. Transactions involving property owned or controlled directly, in whole or in part, by those organizations as mentioned in the preceding Article shall be prohibited.

All such property as mentioned in the preceding paragraph, including books, files and records, shall be seized by, and held in custody of, the Government.

Article 3. The Government shall be authorized to cause all persons having relations with those organizations as mentioned in Article 1 to make necessary declarations in connection with the property mentioned in paragraph 2 of the preceding Article, or dispatch competent officials to any place of necessity and have them execute the inspection of books and other matters of necessity.

Article 4. Any person who, in contravention of the provisions of the preceding Article, has failed to make the required declaration or has made a false declaration, or refused, obstructed, or evaded inspection shall be liable to fine of less than 1,000 yen.

Supplementary Provision:

The present Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.
