(b) The period of time for receiving the applications will be from 24 Apr. to 31 May 1952 (except Sundays and holidays). The application dossiers by post will be accepted, provided that they bear the postmarks of not later than 31 May. The applicant is requested to present the application papers within the said period of time to the Secretariat of the Board of Education of To, Do or prefecture where he wants to take the test. In case of presenting by mail, the applicant must enclose an envelope (with a postage stamp and bearing the address on it) in which the admission ticket for the test will be sent to him.

(c) The application papers shall be prepared according to the provision of Article 7 of the Regulation for the Equivalency Test for the Eligibility to Take University Entrance Examination (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulation"). After the presentation of written application, the applicant shall not be able to change the place of the test and the subjects of the test, nor shall he have his application papers returned, once after they have been received, even if he did not sit for the test.

(d) As the fee for the test, three hundred yen shall be paid in revenue stamp put on the written application. The fee for the test already paid will not be returned on any account.

4. Eligibility for the test:

Those who are eligible for the test shall be those who come under any one of the following items:

(1) Those who have attained sixteen years of age by the time when the equivalency test concerned is operated and who are not enrolled in any upper secondary school;

(2) Those who have graduated the primary course of national elementary schools under the former National Elementary School Ordinance (Imperial Ordinance No. 148 of 1941) (including those who are recognized as being equivalent to them on the basis of the provisions of the laws and ordinances before the enforcement of the School Education Law);

(3) Those who have attained sixteen years of age by the time when the equivalency test is operated and have been taking the correspondence education courses only, which are given by the upper secondary schools in accord-

ance with the provision of Article 45 of the School Education Law.

5. Subjects for the test:

The subjects for the equivalency test shall be as follows:

As for Group I, the whole of four subjects; National Language (A), General Social Studies, Health and Physical Education;

As for Group II, seven subjects in total; one subject selected by the applicant from between National Language (B) and Kambun (or Chinese Classics); one subject selected by the applicant from among Japanese History, World History, Human Geography and Current Problems; two subjects selected by the applicant from among General Mathematics, Analysis (I), Geometry and Analysis (II); two subjects selected by the applicant from among Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Physical Geography, and one subject selected by the applicant from among English, German, French and Chinese;

As for Group III, three subjects selected by the applicant from among eighteen subjects; Japanese History, World History, Human Geography, Current Problems, General Mathematics, Analysis (I), Geometry, Analysis (II), Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Physical Geography, Synthetical Agriculture, General Mechanics, General Electricity, Book-keeping and Accounting, General Fishery and General Home-making, except those subjects selected by the applicant as the subjects in Group II.

However, the subjects for the equivalency test to be taken by those listed in the upper column of items (1) and (2) in the table of paragraph 4 of the Supplementary Provisions of the Regulation shall be as follows:

The subjects for the equivalency test of those who come under the upper column of item (1) shall be five in total; one subject selected by the applicant from among National Language (A), National Language (B) and Kambun; one subject selected by the applicant from among General Social Studies, Japanese History, World History, Human Geography and Current Problems; one subject selected by the applicant from among General Mathematics, Analysis (I), Geometry and Analysis (II); one subject selected by the applicant from among Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Physical Geography, and one subject selected by the applicant from among English, German, French and Chinese.

The subjects for the equivalency test of those

who come under the upper column of item (2) shall be eight in total; one subject selected by the applicant from among National Language (A), National Language (B) and Kambun; two subjects selected by the applicant from among General Social Studies, Japanese History, World History, Human Geography and Current Problems, two subjects selected by the applicant from among General Mathematics, Analysis (I), Geometry and Analysis (II); two subjects selected by the applicant from among Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Physical Geography, and one subject selected by the applicant from among English, German, French and Chinese.

This shall not, however, apply to those who apply for the partial exemption from taking the test of those subjects of the equivalency test as provided for in Article 5 and in paragraph 3 of Article 8 of the Regulation and in paragraph 4 and paragraph 5 of the Supplementary Provisions of the same Regulation.

6. Date of announcement of success:

Each Board of Education of To, Do, Fu or prefecture and each successful candidate are expected to be informed of the success about the middle of September 1952.

As to the partial success, each successful candidate is expected to be informed of it towards the end of October 1952.
