# Ministry of Transportation Notification No. 236

In accordance with the provision of Article 4 of the Transportation Ministry Ordinance No. 40 of November 1945, the following shall be provided for as to the salvaging or refloating of vessels:

# Minister of Transportation TOMABECHI Gizo

If any of the vessels mentioned in the separate list is being salvaged or refloated or if any of them may be used after being salvaged or refloated and repaired, the shipowner (including the shipowners at the time of the disaster) or the ship's husband or the operator thereof shall submit a report stating the following items to the Director-General of General Maritime Bureau, Transportation Ministry, by October 5, 1947:

- 1. Names of the vessels;
- 2. Names and addresses of the present shipowners;
- Names and addresses of the shipowners at the time of disaster;
- 4. Gross tonnage;

- 5. Date and cause of the disaster;
- 6. Location (together with the depth of water);
- 7. Condition of the hull;
- 8. Outline of the salvaging or refloating plan:
  - a. Number of days to the required for salvaging or refloating works;
- b. Salvage operater to whom the works will be entrusted;
- c. Means of financing.
- 9. Use of the vessel.

With regard to a vessel on which the report has not been submitted as provided for in the preceding paragraph, the salvaging or refloating thereof shall not be permitted thereafter.
