In (C) of (2) of 1, "the consigned shall forward the same to the buyers in compliance with their request" shall read "the consignee shall deliver the same to the buyers as specified by the Corporation."

A. Collection (of (1) of 2)

The provisions of A of (1) of 1 shall also apply here.
