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MINISTERIAL ORDINANCE

Ministry of Finance Ordinance No. 31

May 12, 1949

In accordance with the provision of Article 1 of the Temporary Demand and Supply Adjustment Law (Law No. 32, 1946), Ministry of Finance Ordinance concerning the Partial Amendments to the Liquors Distribution Regulations shall be provided as follows:

Ministry of Finance Ordinance concerning the Partial Amendments to the Liquors Distribution Regulations

Part of the Liquors Distribution Regulations (Ministry of Finance Ordinance No. 32, 1948) shall be revised as follows:

In Article 8 par. 1, "fixed by the Minister of Finance with the approval of the Director-General of the Economic Stabilization Board" shall be revised as "prescribed under Article 15 par. 1".

In the proviso to Article 11, "and in case they are delivered for the purpose of exporting." shall be added next to "for the use of each persons".

In Article 15 and Article 16, "with the approval of" shall be revised as "in accordance with the fixed plan determined by".

Article 19 shall be revised as follows:

Article 19. The Superintendent of the Taxation Office may, in case he discovered the fact that the retailer violated the provisions of the present Ministerial Ordinance, the Price Control Ordinance or the Liquor Tax Law, reduce or suspend in a limited duration the allotment of liquors to the retailer concerned or suspend the licensed business concerned or rescind the registration.

The following four Articles shall be added next to Article 19.

Article 19-(2). The retailer prosecuted according to the provisions of the preceding Article, shall make public notice at the front door or some other visible place in sale store, the matter of the prosecution, on the form specified by the

Superintendent of the Taxation Office, during the specified term.

Article 19-(3). In case the disposition as provided under Article 19 is executed, the Superintendent of the Taxation Office shall request the retailer concerned or his agent to present oneself or to file the written explanation thereof and examine the conditions thereon. Provided, however, in case the violation as provided under the same Article is evident and the immediate disposition is deemed necessary, he may dispose him prior to examining the conditions thereon.

Article 19-(4). In case the examination according to the provisions of the preceding Article is executed, the Superintendent of the Taxation Office shall notify the retailer concerned the date, the time limit and the place of presence or the date and the time limit of filing the written explanation not less than ten days before the date of the examination. Provided, however, in case the disposition according to the provisions of the proviso to the same Article is executed, he shall notify the matter to the retailer concerned simultaneously with the disposition. In this case, the date and the timelimit of presence or of filing the written explanation shall be during from tenth day to twentieth day after the notification of disposition was issued.

In case the notification of the preceding paragraph is issued, the Superintendent of the Taxation Office shall add the investigation bill under the supervising officer's hand and seal, who executed the investigation of violation fact as the cause of disposition, to the notice indicating the reason for disposition.

The Superintendent of the Taxation Office, in case he deems it necessary, may command or request the produce of evidence, specifing the date, to the retailer concerned or to the control authority prescribed in the preceding paragraph after the examination.

Article 19-(5). The Superintendent of the Taxation Office shall decide, within ten days after the examination according to the provisions of the preceding two Articles, (in case the produce of evidence is commanded or requested according to the provisions of paragraph 3 of the preceding Article, within ten days after the specified day), whether the disposition should be executed, or withdrawn, and simultaneously shall notify the matter to the retailer concerned. Provided, however, in case the retailer concerned or his agent does not present oneself or not file the written explanation or the evidence at the specified day, the Superintendent of the Taxation Office may dispose according to his presumption during from sixth day to tenth day after the specified day.

In the paragraph 1 of Article 20, "specifing the time and method of transfer" shall be added next to "for Liquor Distribution Public Corporation," and item 3 of the same paragraph shall be revised as follows:

3 In case the retailer is suspended the licensed business concerned or rescinded the registration in accordance with the provisions of Article 19

In Article 21, par. 1, "to the Director of Regional Financial Bureau within ten days after the day prosecuted" shall be revised as "to the Director-General of the Economic Stabilization Board within twenty days after the day notified the decision of disposition", item 5 of the same paragraph shall be revised as follows:

5 Those who were reduced or suspended the allotment of liquors or suspended the licensed business concerned or rescinded the registration in accordance with the provisions of Article 19.

Par. 3 and par. 4 of the same Article shall be revised as follows, and par. 5 and par. 6 shall be deleted:

In case the objection is in accordance with the provisions of par. 1, the Superintendent of the Taxation Office shall send at once the report on the deposition of the demurrant or written explanation and other necessary documents concerned to the Director-General of the Economic Stabilization Board.

Even in case the objection to the disposition is stated in accordance with the provisions of par. 1, the effect of the disposition shall not be invalid.

The following Article shall be added next to Article 21:

Article 21-(2). In case under par. 1 of the preceding Article, the notice of judgment is received within fifty days after the statement of objection was taken up, or in case the case is sent back to reinvestigate, the Superintendent of the Taxation Office shall take necessary measures according to the decision.

In case the decision by the Director-General of the Economic Stabilization Board is not performed within the duration mentioned in the preceding paragraph, the Superintendent of the Taxation Office shall take necessary measures, deeming the statement as legal.

Supplementary Provisions:

1. The present Ministerial Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

2. As to the case of which the objection is stated before the enforcement of the revised Article 21, it shall still follow the example heretofore.
