### Imperial Ordinance

No. 299

DRAFT OF THE AMENDED SYSTEM OF OFFICIAL ORGANIZATION RELATING TO THE RAILWAY COUNCIL

Article 1. The Railway Council shall be under the supervision of the Minister of Transportation and shall inquire into and deliberate upon all matters concerning the conduct of the affairs of the Japanese Government Railways when such matters are submitted by him for deliberation.

The Council may make proposals regarding the matters referred to in the foregoing paragraph to the ministers of State concerned.

Article 2. In deciding on matters itemized below, besides the matters provided for in Article 4 of the Railway Construction Law, deliberation by the Council is deemed necessary.

1. Formulation of programs for enterprise of the Japanese Government Railways and of other fundamental plans.
2. Important matters pertaining to railway fares and rates and other terms of transport.
3. Permission or otherwise pertaining to

the construction not only of such lines of private railways as correspond to the scheduled railway lines inserted in the table attached to the Railway Construction Law, but also of such lines of private railways as threaten to affect seriously other railway lines or tramway lines (including those on which services are not yet in operation) to which the lines in question run close, if not parallel with them; purchase of private railways or tramways; compensation as provided for in Article 36 of the Private Railway Law or in Article 26 of the Tramway Law; and rent and trusteeship of operations concerning private railways.

4. Selection of important ferry and automobile lines operated by the State.

Article 3. The Council shall be made up of no more than 40 members.

Article 4. The members of the Council shall consist of the following:

1. No more than two officials of the Ministry of Transportation.
2. No more than four officials of other ministries concerned.
3. No more than five members of the House of Peers.
4. No more than eight members of the House of Representatives.
5. No more than twenty-one representatives nominated by the organizations specified by the Minister of Transportation.

The members of the Council shall be appointed by the Cabinet, upon request of the Ministry of Transportation.

The term of office of the members shall be one year, but any member may be replaced by another during his tenure of office, provided such replacement is due to some specific reason.

Article 5. The Council shall have a Chairman

elected by the members from among themselves.

The Chairman shall control the affairs of the Council.

In the event of the Chairman being prevented from assuming his duties, one of the members elected from among themselves shall act in his place.

Article 6. The Council may, by its decision, appoint a sub-council to deal with matters coming under the purview of the Council.

The Council may, by its provisions, regard the decision of the sub-council as the decision of the Council itself.

Article 7. The Council may appoint a committee of experts to investigate matters demanding technical treatment.

A committee of experts shall be appointed by the Cabinet, upon the nomination of the Chairman and upon request of the Minister of Transportation.

Article 8. The Council may, when necessary, request sub-mission of data or explanations by officials of the ministries concerned.

Article 9. The cabinet shall have one chief secretary and a number of other secretaries to the Council.

The chief secretary and other secretaries shall be appointed by the Cabinet upon request of the Minister of Transportation.

The chief secretary shall supervise, by order of the Chairman, the conduct of the general affairs of the Council.

The secretaries shall conduct the general affairs of the Council under the directions of the Chairman and the chief secretary.

Article 10. The Council shall have a number of clerks.

The clerks shall be appointed by the Minister of Transportation.

The clerks shall engage in the conduct of the general affairs under the directions of the Council secretaries.

#### Supplementary Provisions:

This Imperial Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

The system of official organization pertaining to the council for railway fares and rates shall be abolished.

I hereby give my sanction to the Ordinance Prohibiting Possession of Firearms and Other Weapons under the Imperial Ordinance No. 542 of the twentieth year of Showa (1945) concerning the Orders to be issued in consequence of my acceptance of the Potsdam Declaration, and cause the same to be promulgated.

### Imperial Ordinance

No. 300

#### IMPERIAL ORDINANCE PROHIBITING POSSESSION OF FIREARMS AND OTHER WEAPONS

Article 1. The possession of firearms, explosives, or swords (hereinafter called firearms or other weapons) shall be prohibited excepting the cases where they are possessed for legitimate duty purposes in accordance with the laws and ordinances, as well as any of the cases where, by virtue of the decisions by the Minister of Home Affairs, a special permission is obtained from the Prefectural Governor concerned (or from the Superintendent-General of the Metropolitan Police Board in the case of the Metropolitan Area of Tokyo) regarding one of the following items:

1. Those necessary for the extermination of harmful birds and beasts.
2. Those required by professional hunters for their business purposes.
3. Swords having value as objects of art.
4. Explosives required for industrial purposes.

The scope of the firearms or other weapons as specified in the preceding paragraph shall be determined by the Minister of Home Affairs. *paragraph 1*

Article 2. Any person, who does not obtain premission or obtains it by fraudulent means in violation of the preceding Article and keep firearms or other weapons, shall be liable to an imprisonment with or with-

20 - *In permitting the possession of swords mentioned in the preceding Paragraph, No. 3, in accordance with the provisions*

out hard labor not exceeding three years or to a fine not exceeding 5,000 yen. Firearms or other weapons in the possession of any person, except where they are confiscated through judicial process, shall be forfeited by administrative disposition no matter where their ownership lies.

Article 3. Besides what are determined by the present Ordinance, all matters necessary for prohibiting possession of firearms or other weapons shall be determined by the Minister of Home Affairs.

Supplementary Provisions:

The present Ordinance shall come into force as from June 15, 1946.

Any person (including his successor) who keeps firearms or other weapons at the time of enforcement of the present Ordinance and intends to keep them successively after enforcement thereof, shall apply for permission within two months according to the provisions of Article 1. Pending the disposal of permission or prohibition for the above application, the applicant is deemed as having obtained permission according to the same Article.

## COLLECTIVE INFORMATION

### OFFICIAL PARTICULARS

#### Revision of the Regulations for the Subdivision of the Finance Ministry

The Ministry of Finance made the following amendments to the Regulations for the Subdivision of the Finance Ministry and put into force as from 1 June 1946.

The following amendments are made to the Regulations for the Subdivision of the Financial Bureau:

In Article 1, "Foreign Funds Section, Reparations Section" shall read "Holding Company Liquidation Section, Foreign Funds Section."

In Article 3, Item 3 after "industrial funds" add "(excluding matters under the jurisdiction of the Holding Company Liquidation Section)," in Item 4 after "Banking Bureau" add "and Holding Company Liquidation Section" and Item 11 shall be deleted.

Article 5 shall be deleted and Article 4 shall be Article 5, and at the end of Item 11 of the same article add "(excluding matters

under the jurisdiction of the Special Financial Affairs Department).”

Article 4. The Holding Company Liquidation Section shall manage the following affairs:

1. Liquidation of holding companies.
2. Adjustment of industrial funds and matters relating to company accounting of holding companies.

### Regulations for the Organization of the Special Financial Department

The Ministry of Finance made the following Regulations for the Organization of the Special Financial Department and put into force as from 1 June 1946.

Article 1. The Special Financial Department shall comprise of three sections namely Financial Section, Property Custodian Section and Foreign Property Section, and shall administer the affairs enumerated in the following articles.

Article 2. The Financial Section shall administer the following affairs:

1. The affairs regarding the financial problems of reparation;
2. The affairs regarding the investigation relative to reparations;
3. The affairs regarding the expenditures in connection with the termination of war;
4. The affairs regarding the supervision on the payments of expenditures relative to the termination of war; and
5. The affairs which are not handled by the other two sections of this department.

Article 3. The Property Custodian Section shall administer the following affairs:

1. The affairs regarding the investigation of properties located outside of Japan;
2. The affairs regarding the disposition of closed financial institutions; and
3. The affairs regarding designated properties.

Article 4. Foreign Property Section shall administer the following affairs:

1. The affairs regarding the properties owned by Allied Powers; and
2. The affairs regarding the properties owned by specially designated countries.

### Regulation of or the Organization of the Custom-House

The Regulations on the Subdivisions of the Customs shall be enacted and put into force as from June 1, 1946.

The Regulations on the Operation of Each Sections of the Customs.

Art. 1. The Customs shall have a Secretariat of the Director of the Customs. The Department of Superintendent, the Trade Department and the Inspection Department.

Art. 2. The Secretariat of the Chief of the Customs shall have General Affairs Section, Accounting Section and Training Section.

Art. 3. The General Affairs Section of the Secretariat of the Director of the Customs shall be charged with:

1. Affairs concerning secrecy,
2. Affairs concerning personnels,
3. Affairs concerning the custody and handling of official seals,
4. Affairs concerning inspection, proving and handling of documents,
5. Affairs concerning the receiving, delivery, mailing, compiling and custody of documents,
6. Affairs concerning protest, appeal and law suit,
7. Affairs concerning customs broker,
8. Affairs concerning the special opening and operation of the offices, and
9. Affairs not belonging to other sections or departments.

Art. 4. The Accounting Section of the Secretariat of the Director of Customs shall handle:

1. Affairs concerning expenditures,
2. Affairs concerning Government properties and articles,
3. Affairs concerning the moneys to be given and various rebates,
4. Affairs concerning building and repairs,
5. Affairs concerning mutual benefit association, and
6. Affairs concerning employees.

Art. 5. The Training Section of the secretariat of the Chief of the Customs shall be charged with:

1. Affairs concerning the education of the customs personnel regarding the necessary knowledge and practice of customs

administration, and

2. Affairs concerning the general affairs in reference to the training of customs personnel.

Art. 6. The Superintendent Department shall have the police Affairs Section, Investigation Section, and Freight Section.

Art. 7. The Police Affairs Section, of the Department of Superintendent shall handle:

1. Affairs concerning the investigation of the documents in connection with export goods,
2. Affairs concerning the permit, special permit and disposition of other matters regarding export goods, and
3. Affairs concerning the enforcement of Foreign Exchange Control Law regarding export goods.

Art. 12. The Import Section of the Trade Department shall be charged with:

1. Affairs concerning the investigation of the documents of import goods,
2. Affairs concerning the permit, special permit and disposition of other matters regarding import goods,
3. Affairs concerning the levying and collecting duties and tonnage taxes,
4. Affairs concerning the levying and collecting domestic taxes on import goods,
5. Affairs concerning various customs incomes,
6. Affairs concerning the security of duties,
7. Affairs concerning the enforcement of the Foreign Exchange Control Law in connection with import goods,

Art. 13. The Statistics Section of the Business Department shall be charged with:

1. affairs concerning the investigation of foreign trade,
2. Affairs concerning the preparation and compilation of statistics and various lists, and
3. Affairs concerning the delivery of statistical lists and tables.

Art. 14. The Department of Inspection shall have export Inspection Section, Import Inspection Section and Investigation Section.

Art. 15. The Export Inspection Section of the Inspection Department shall be charged with affairs concerning the inspection and examination of export goods.

Art. 16. The Import Inspection Section of the Inspection Department shall be charged with affairs concerning the inspection and examination of import goods.

Art. 17. The Investigation Section of the Department of Inspection shall be charged with:

1. Affairs concerning the investigation of market prices of goods, and other necessary investigation in connection with the inspection and examination of goods,
2. Affairs concerning analysis,
3. Affairs concerning the collection of samples and their safe-keeping, and
4. Affairs concerning the filing and safe-keeping of invoices.

## THE IMPERIAL DIET

### THE HOUSE OF PEERS

#### The House of Peers Organized

The House of Peers organized for business by deciding the Seats of Members and allotting the Members to various sections on May 16, 1946.

#### The Seats in the House

**Re: Execution of Examination for Qualification of Chief Technician of Electric Enterprise**
