Part of the Regulations of Certification Test of Electric Apparatus is revised as follows:

Article 1. Part of the Regulations of Certification Test Electric Apparatus is revised as follows.

The phrase "with revenue stamps" in Article 3, paragraph 1, shall be deleted.

In Article 10 "a 25 *sen* revenue stamp must be pasted on every sheet as fee" shall read "a fee of 25 *sen* must be paid for every sheet."

AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS FOR THE FEE OF WORKS PRESENTED BY GREAT JAPAN MUSICAL COPYRIGHT ASSOCIATION

Gist of the Amendment of Regulations for the Fee of Works presented by Great Japan Musical Copyright Association, a Corporate Juridical Person

December 1946

The following application for the authorization of amendment of the regulations for the fee of works has been presented from Great Japan Musical Copyright Association, a corporate juridical person. The gist of it shall hereby be published in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 3 of "Law of Intermediate Business concerning Copyright."

Ministry for Home Affairs

Item 2. Matters concerning the rate of fee of works

The fee of works controlled by this Organization shall be as follows:

1. Fee of western musical works

A. Performance

The following shall be belonged to light music.

1. Musical composition

Dancing music, popular description music, connection music and other popular music.

Concert of Japanese and European music, Japanese songs music, popular songs music, people's song, military song, children's song, song, jazz and revue music, operetta music, comic opera music and other music similar to these.

2. Musical instrument

Harmonica, guitar, mandolin, accordion, xylophone and other musical instrument similar to these.

The following shall be belonged to genuine music. Music except light music.

D. Publication.

1. A fee for printing in a magazine:

A fee of one page of text and melody is decided by circulation of a magazine as shown in the following table. When two or more pieces are printed in one page, a fee of each piece is also decided by this table.

 - 2) If a price is fixed but a copyright owner does not appointed the rate of royalty, 10 per cent of the fixed price is regarded to be the rate of royalty. If a price is not fixed, a fee is decided by means and sum designated by a copyright owner. If a price is not fixed and is not designated by a copyright owner, the fee for usage shall be decided according to a fee for printing in a magazine.
 - 3) When a musical note is printed in a book, the fee is decided according to a fee for printing in a magazine.
 - 4) When a musical note the copyright of which lapsed and one the copyright of which exists are used together, a fee is decided by dividing proportionally with one whose copyright exists based on the rate of royalty designated by a copyright owner.
3. Lease of a musical note.

A fee of lease of a musical note is designated by a copyright owner, but, if he does not designate it 10 per cent of a fee of lease is regarded to be a fee usage.

E. Either a melody or an instrumental music has no copyright, the rate shown in the following table shall be reduced from the fundamental fee. (In case of broadcasting, a fee of a portion which has no copyright shall be reduced.)

- A concert with a public nature 20 to 50 per cent discount.
 A learning concert (provided that an admission fee is not more than 10 yen and it is held in a hall which seats not more than 500)..... 20 to 50 per cent discount.
 Accompaniment or entertainment of athletic meeting free.

B. Discount by city, town or village:

- (1) Cities except Tokyo, Osaka, Kyoto, Nagoya, Kobe, Yokohama, Fukuoka and Sendai 30 per cent discount.
 The other towns and villages 50 per cent discount.

Remarks:

- (1) If "a discount considering the nature of a concert" is duplicated, a discount shall be allowed by the highest rate of discount.
 (2) If "a discount considering the nature of a concert" and "a discount by city, town or village" are duplicated, "a discount by city, town or village" shall be allowed first, and then "a discount considering the nature of a concert" shall be allowed.

C. Discount in broadcasting:

- a) Except broadcasting from Tokyo Central Broadcasting Station, a discount shall be allowed by the following rate.
 (1) Osaka Central Broadcasting Station 30 per cent discount.
 (2) Each Central Broadcasting Station except Tokyo and Osaka... 60 per cent discount.
 (3) The other broadcasting station 70 per cent discount.

Remarks: In the case of broadcasting by relay, a discount shall be allowed according to the broadcasting station concerned whose charge is the highest.

- b) A broadcasting which is regarded as a special one by this Association, such as overseas broadcasting, recording broadcasting, etc., a discount may be allowed according to the agreement with Japan Broadcasting Co-operation.

D. Discount in publication:

When a musical note is printed in a book and it is regarded to have a special aim, a discount of fee may be allowed by not exceeding 50 per cent.
