The following remark shall be added to Appendix No. 4:

Note 4. The Government office in charge of the demandant in the "Column of Agency issuing Transportation Certificate" shall

mean the competent Ministry listed in Appendix No. 2 of the Designated Production Materials Allocation Regulations, and the Prefectural Governor, to whom part of the authorizations of the competent Minister set forth in the Designated Production Materials Allocation Regulations has been delegated in accordance with the provisions of the ordinances and regulations under the Temporary Materials Demand and Supply Adjustment Law, shall be regarded as the above competent Ministry.

Note 1., (a) in Appendix No. 4 shall be amended as follows:

1. In case the allocation certificate of a certain designated production material is issued by the Ministry of Construction or the Prefectural Governor under the Temporary Construction, etc. Restriction Regulations or the Temporary Miners' Housing Construction Regulations, the issuing agency of the transportation certificate for the said material shall be the Ministry of Construction or the Prefectural Governor.

4. For the cases of building the following structures in coal mine;
 - 1) Facilities within mine,
 - 2) Removal equipments from place to place as operation proceeds, such as watch-house, etc.,
 - 3) Damaged equipments required of urgent repairing,
 - 4) Repairing of building and structures in coal mines.
5. For the case of oil prospecting: Building of tower for boring, engine-house, pump-house, mud-plant, rest-room, carpentry sheds, storage, dormitory and office;
6. For the case of boring oil well: Building of tower for boring, engine-house, pump-house, mud-plant and rest-house;
7. For the case of building the following buildings according to the plan, made by the President of ESB for the use of working-men (including employees in general) of sulphide mine and lignite mines;

Housing, dormitory, hospital, dispensary, patient-room, school, assembly, bath-house, barber shop, community kitchen, materials allocation office, public w.c., office for housing superintendent and other facilities appertained.

8. For the case by order of Allied Forces repairs of building to be done for safeguarding reparation machines in factories designated for reparation by Allied Forces.
9. For the case of building necessary for relief to be carried out by Prefectural Governor in accordance with Disaster Relief Law (Law No. 118 of 1947) including the case of transferring part of powers to mayor, town or village head (including special ward head) respecting execution of relief according to rules of Art. 30 of the same Law).
