Imperial Ordinance No. 63

The following amendments shall partially be made to the Regulations governing the Organization of the Divisions and Sections attached to the Cabinet and of the Personnels thereof:

Next to Article 2 item 5 shall be added the following item, and item 6 shall be made item 7, and the following shall be shifted down by turns:

6. Matters concerning the enforcement of the Imperial Ordinance No. 1 of 1947 (Imperial Ordinance concerning exclusion, retirement, etc. in respect of public service), and matters concerning the control thereof as well as the Public Service Qualifications Examination Committee and the Public Service Petition Examination Committee.

In Article 7, "Full time 18 persons" shall be amended as "Full time 15 persons," "Full time 141 persons" shall be amended as "Full time 135 persons."

Supplementary Provisions:

The present Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

The following amendments shall be made partially to the Regulations governing the Organization of Establishment of Temporary Personnels in the Cabinet:

Article 1. The following personnels shall be posted in the Cabinet so that they may transact matters concerning the enforcement of the Imperial Ordinance No. 1 of 1947 (Imperial Ordinance concerning exclusion, retirement, etc. in respect of public office) and matters concerning the control thereof as well as the matters relative to the Public Service Qualifications Examination Committee:

Imperial Ordinance No. 64

A part of Imperial Ordinance No. 2 of 1947 shall be amended as follows:

In Article 2, (2), "and of chief of Chōnaikai, Burakukai or its federation" and "and No. 4" shall be deleted.

In Article 2, "and also chief of Chōnaikai, Burakukai or its federation within the city boundary" shall be deleted.

In Article 3, "a copy of" shall be deleted.

In Article 12, paragraph 1, "The Committee" shall read "The Committee (excluding the Central Committee)"; and in paragraph 2 thereof, "in the case of the Central Committee, by the Cabinet" shall be deleted.

Articles 12 and 13 shall be advanced respectively to Articles 13 and 14.

Article 12. shall be as follows:

Article 12. In order to deal with miscellaneous matters, the Central Public Office Qualification Examination Committee shall have a Secretariat.

The Secretariat shall be composed of the following personnel:

Secretariat members	
Cabinet officials	
Second class	7 (full time)
Third class	15 (full time)

Chief-Secretary shall be appointed by the Prime Minister from among men of knowledge and experience.

Chief-Secretary shall supervise administration of the business of Secretariat under direction of the Chairman of the Committee.

Secretariat members shall be filled with the Cabinet officials mentioned in paragraph 2 above.

Secretariat members, besides those mentioned in the preceding paragraph, may be appointed or commissioned by the Cabinet from among government officials of each Ministry concerned or men of knowledge and experience.

Secretariat members shall dispose of the business of the Secretariat under direction of the Chief-Secretary.

With regard to the persons who are not government officials and have been appointed as Chief-Secretary of Secretariat members, the provisions of the Regulations of Discipline of Government Officials shall be applied correspondingly.

Supplementary Provision:

The present Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

Imperial Ordinance No. 65

Article 1. Any person who has been designated as falling under the Memorandum in accordance with the provisions of Imperial Ordinance No. 109 of 1946 or of Imperial Ordinance No. 1 of 1947, and as a consequence thereof removed or barred from appointment or election to a position in the public service may, in the event he deems that an error has been made in his case, file an appeal for a rescission of designation to the Prime Minister.

The Prime Minister, upon acceptance of the appeal prescribed in the preceding paragraph, may, on the basis of the findings and recommendations of the Public Office Qualifications Appeal Board, rescind the designation.

Article 2. Any person who intends to appeal in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph 1 of the preceding Article shall submit a letter of appeal to the Prime Minister, stating clearly reasons for justification of his case and together with relevant documents for evidence.

In case the appellant has been designated as falling under the Memorandum by the Prefectural Governor, the letter of appeal prescribed in the preceding paragraph shall be submitted through the Prefectural Governor. In this case, upon acceptance of documents pertaining to the appeal, the Prefectural Governor concerned shall forward them immediately, together with statement of his opinion and the questionnaire of the appellant, to the Prime Minister.

The Prime Minister, upon acceptance of documents pertaining to the appeal, shall forward them immediately, together with a statement of his opinion (concerning the case prescribed in the preceding paragraph, the statement of the Prefectural Governor) and the questionnaire of the appellant, to the Public Office Qualifications Appeal Board.

Article 3. The appeal prescribed in Article 1, paragraph 1 above shall be filed within three months from the day of designation as falling under the Memorandum.

Validity of designation as falling under the Memorandum shall not be affected by filing of the appeal prescribed in Article 1, paragraph 1 above.

Article 4. The rescission of designation as falling under the Memorandum shall be effected by notification of the Prime Minister to the appellant.

In case the designation be rescinded, the designation shall lose its validity from the day of its rescission. In this case, the provisions of Article 5, paragraph 1 of the Imperial Ordinance No. 1 of 1947 (including corresponding provisions of Imperial Ordinance No. 109 of 1946 replaced by the former Imperial Ordinance) shall be deemed as not having been applied.

Article 5. The Prime Minister, when he has taken measures for the rescission or for other necessary matters, on the basis of consequence of examination by the Public Office Qualifications Appeal Board, shall publish the facts immediately.

Article 6. Any person who has submitted the statement of reasons or documents prescribed in Article 2 above containing false entry or entry lacking full and complete disclosure shall be liable to the penal servitude of not more than three years or to a fine of not more than ¥15,000. Any person who has been requested to present materials or an explanation of facts and fails in doing so or who submits materials containing false information or lacking full and complete disclosure of facts on important matters shall be likewise liable to the same punishment.

Supplementary Provisions:

The present Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

The period prescribed in the Article 3, paragraph 1 above shall, with persons who have been designated as falling under the Memorandum prior to the issuance of this Imperial Ordinance, be three months from the date of its promulgation.

Imperial Ordinance No. 66

Regulations on Organization of Public Office Qualifications Appeal Board

Article 1. The Public Office Qualifications Appeal Board shall, under the supervision of the Prime Minister, conduct examinations necessary for rescission of designation as falling under the Memo-

random in pursuance of the provisions of the Imperial Ordinance No. 65 of 1947.

Article 2. The Board shall be composed of not more than seven members.

In case it deems necessary for examining special matters, temporary members may be appointed, provided that they shall not vote in a final decision of the Board.

Article 3. The chairman shall be elected from among members.

Members and temporary members shall be appointed by the Cabinet.

Article 4. A quorum of five members including the chairman is required for holding a session of the Board.

Final decisions of the Board shall be made by the majority of the members present provided they constitute a quorum including the chairman.

The chairman shall vote on all issues and in the event of a tie, the chairman shall cast a second and deciding vote.

Article 5. In case of necessity for examination, the Board may request from the Prime Minister or from the Prefectural Governor an explanation concerning reasons for designating the appellant as falling under the Memorandum or may cause the appellant or other persons concerned to present necessary materials or to give explanations of facts.

Article 6. The chairman, members or temporary members shall not disclose any information concerning matters connected with the official duties of the Board, except for information released by the Prime Minister.

Article 7. The Board shall have Secretaries.

Secretaries shall be appointed or commissioned, from among government officials and persons of knowledge and experience, by the Cabinet.

Secretaries shall take charge of miscellaneous matters under the direction of their superiors.

Article 8. The procedure of examination and other necessary matters relating to the affairs of the Board shall be determined by the chairman.

Supplementary Provision:

The present Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

Art. 8, par. 4 shall be amended as follows:

The Prime Minister or the prefectural governor may, when he accepts the questionnaire prescribed in par. 2, ask for additionally necessary copies of the questionnaire from candidates whom he deems necessary.

In Art. 9, par. 3, "prescribed in the preceding two paragraphs" shall read "prescribed in the first or the second paragraph above." The following shall be added as the third paragraph:

The certificate of eligibility issued by the prefectural governor in accordance with the provisions of the preceding two paragraphs shall be invalid regarding public offices to be designated by the Prime Minister according to the Appendix III

and candidates thereof.

In Appendix II No. 3, "in case of the Public Office Qualifications Examination Committee, including those of the prefectural and municipal level" shall be added before "in case of the Land Committee."

In No. 4, "headman of ward in Tokyo Metropolis" shall read "headman and assembly member of ward in Tokyo Metropolis."

No. 6 shall be deleted.

In No. 9, "Gyogyo Kai (including all of local level) shall read "Gyogyo Kai."

In Appendix III No. 3, next to "covering several prefectures," shall be added "and all committee members of the Public Office Qualifications Examination Committee." Next to "prefectural level or below" shall be added "(excluding committee members of the Public Office Qualifications Examination Committee of the prefectural level or below)."

No. 6 shall be deleted.

In No. 7, next to "All of the public offices," shall be added (excluding the public offices of Shokuryo Eidan of the prefectural level." "None" shall read "the public offices of Shokuryo Eidan of the prefectural level."

Nos. 7 to 13 shall be respectively moved up by one.

In Form No. 1, Questionnaire, A, par. 1, a, next to "Position for which you are under consideration" shall be added "(in case of a candidate for public election, the kind of election and the electoral district)"; and in par. 9, "Present address;" shall read "Present address: (telephone number)."

In par. 22, item 12 shall read item 11.

Par. 24 shall be amended as follows:

24. 1. In case you have been screened under the provisions of Imperial Ordinance No. 109 of 1946, or Cabinet & Home Ministry Ordinance No. 1 of 1946, which were effective through January 3, 1947, indicate: (a) the title of the position for which you were screened and the organization in which it was located; (b) the result and approximate date of the screening action (whether passed, removed or barred)

The theory-examination shall be limited to the graduates of the schools of pharmacy who had completed the course of middle-school or girls' high school, or those having the qualification equal to or more than those mentioned above.

The practice-examination shall be limited to those who took the theory-examination and passed it.

5. The procedure necessary to the written application.

Those who want to take the theory-examination shall file the written application with the following papers to the Medicinal Affairs Section, Public Health Department, Shizuoka-ken:

- (1) Personal History
- (2) Identity card (Certificate in accordance with Article 3 and Article 4 of the Enforcement Act of the Medicinal Affairs Law)
- (3) Graduation certificate by the principal of the middle-school or girls' high school (those who have the qualification equal to or more than that of graduates of the middle school or girls')

- (4) Photograph (card-sized, with the mount, photographed within six months before the application, and on its back the kind of the examination applied for, date of photographing, and the name of the person to be written.

Those who want to take the practice-examination shall file, to the Ministry of Welfare, the written application for the examination, together with No. 1, No. 2 and No. 4 papers of the aforesaid papers, and the copy of the certificate of passing the pharmacists' theory-examination, or that of the approval of the pharmacists' theory-examination.
