#### Law No. 211

The Law for the Establishment of the Agency for the Affairs of Allocation of Paper for Newspapers and Publications

(Object and principle of establishment)

Article 1. Because the shortage of paper supply under the present state of national economy necessitates machinery to ensure equitable allocation among newspapers and publications of such paper as may be provided for this purpose, there shall be temporarily established by the present Law under the control of the Prime Minister an Agency for the Affairs of Allocation of paper for Newspapers and Publications (hereinafter to be called the Agency).

Article 2. Nobody shall interfere with freedom of expression or force upon others adherence to any particular thought by exerting pressure on, or by making use of paper allocation in any way.

(Scope of authority and responsibility)

Article 3. The scope of authority and responsibility of the Agency shall be as follows, and its functions shall be carried out within the aforesaid scope in accordance with the laws and orders based on laws:

- To accept and examine applications for allocation of paper for newspapers and publications and to make draft plan of allocation which shall be presented to the Council of the Allocation of Paper for Newspapers and Publications (hereinafter in this Article to be called the Council);
- To issue allocation tickets or to revoke them in case of necessity in accordance with the resolutions made by the Council;
- To exercise surveillance over the delivery and consumption of allocated paper for newspapers and publications, and to take proper measures in case any facts of violations of rules and regula-

tions are found;

- To accept written pleas and objections concerning allocation of paper and refer them to the Council for consideration;
- To investigate and collect materials on matters related with the preceding items;
- To preserve records of the meetings of the Council and the Panels and make them accessible for review to any interested party;
- 7. To publish the results of allocation.

The Prime Minister, when he deems it especially necessary, can entrust the affairs of control within the scope of his authority in accordance with Article 1 to one of the State Ministers.

(Staff and organization)

Article 4. The chief of the Agency shall be the Director of the Agency.

The Director of the Agency shall take charge of the matters enumerated in Article 3.

Necessary matters concerning the staff of the Agency other than those provided for by this Law shall be stipulated by a Cabinet Order.

Necessary matters concerning the details of the organization of the Agency shall be laid down by the Director.

(Council for allocation of paper for newspapers and publications)

Article 5. The Council for the Allocation of Paper for Newspapers and Publications (hereinafter to be called the Council) shall be set up in the Agency.

The Council shall consider on important matters concerning allocation of paper for newspapers and publications, including those enumerated in the items of Article 6.

- Article 6. The Director of the Agency must refer the matters concerning the following items to the Council without exceptions, and shall give decisions in accordance with the resolutions of the Council:
  - Principles, standards and procedures concerning the allocation of paper for newspapers and publications;
  - Allocation of paper for individual newspapers and publications.

Article 7. The Council shall consist of the Newspaper Panel and the Publication Panel, each of which shall consist of eleven members.

Members of each Panel shall consist of five persons chosen from among the business field concerned, five persons chosen from among men of knowledge and experience and the Chief of the Bureau of the Ministry of Commerce and Industry that takes charge of paper affairs.

Article 8. At the time of election of the Members of the Council, the Chairman of the Council shall choose candidates taking advices from various circles concerned.

The Director of the Agency, when he has justifiable reasons to regard any candidate of the preceding paragraph as unsuitable, can ask its withdrawal to the Chairman, but he must not do so more than twice for each post.

The Chairman of the Council, when asked for withdrawal of any candidate, shall choose a new candidate.

Each Panel shall elect its Members out of acceptable candidates by majority votes.

Article 9. Besides the stipulations of the preceding two Articles, matters concerning the organization and operation of the Council, election of Chairmen, term of office, procedures of choice and election, appointment and dismissal of Members, and matters necessary in relation with the present Committee for the Allocation of Paper for Newspapers and Publications at the time of the establishment of the Council shall be stipulated by a Cabinet Order.

(Principles and standards of allocation)

Article 10. Allocation of paper for newspapers and publications should be equitable and fair.

Principles concerning allocation of paper for newspapers and publications should be so laid down that they raise moral and cultural standard of Japan and contribute to create a democratic society.

Standards concerning allocation of paper for newspapers and publications should be laid down as objectively as possible, taking into consideration such criteria as cultural value, social usefulness, public demands, etc.

Supplementary Provisions:

- This Law shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.
- Regulations governing the Organization of Temporary Establishment of the Office for Allocation of Paper for Newspapers and Publications (Imperial Ordinance No. 566, 1946) shall be abolished.
- 3. In order to give the Diet a chance to review the necessity to continue allocation of paper and the worthiness of the present allocation system, the Government shall take steps to get the approval by resolution of the Diet at each of its ordinary sessions as to the continuance of the present Law without any revision.
- 4. In the case of the preceding paragraph, the pretsen Law shall continue to be in force without revi sion if the Diet resolves to that effect. If the Diet resolves to revise or abolish the present Law,

the Government must take necessary measures.

#### Law No. 212

Law for Establishment of the Deliberation Comission on the Measures for Repatriates

Article 1. Based upon the resolution concerning the measures for repatriates, which was adopted in the Second Session of the Diet, the Prime Minister's Office Deliberation Commission on the measures for Repatriates (hereinafter to be called Deliberation Commission) shall be established in order to conduct investigations and deliberations on the following matters:

- Matters concerning the promotion of repatriation:
- Matters concerning the relief of bereaved families and dependents of unrepatriated persons;
- 3. Matters concerning the employment, farming and enterprises of the repatriates, as a measure for their regeneration:
- Matters concerning the overseas assets of the repatriates;
- 5. Matters concerning the repatriates, other than the above items.

The Deliberation Commission shall come under the supervision of the Prime Minister.

Article 2. The Deliberation Commission shall, upon deliberations on representations of civilians concerning the matters stated in par. 1, Article 1, and investigation into actual circumstances, study the measures for repatriates and report its result to the Prime Minister.

Article 3. The Deliberation Commission shall be composed of one (1) chairman, and members not exceeding fifteen (15) persons.

The Minister of Welfare concurrently shall be appointed the chairman.

The Prime Minister shall appoint the members from among the Vice-Ministers of the Ministries concerned, the President of the Sepatriation Relief Agency, representatives of repatriation organizations authorized by the Welfare Minister and the men of learning and experience.

Article 4. The chairman shall administer the business of the Commission.

In case the chairman is prevented for some un-avoidable reason from performing his duties, a member nominated by the Prime Minister shall act for him.

Article 5. The Deliberation Commission shall have the following personnel in order to dispose of the business of the Commission:

The Chief Secretary: one person; other personnel: several persons.

The Chief Secretary shall be appointed by the Prime Minister from among the first-class officials of the Welfare Ministry.

The officials other them the Chief Secretary shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Deliberative Commission.

Supplementary Provisions:

Article 6. The date of enforcement of this Law shall be set by a cabinet order, provided that it shall be within thirty days from the promulgation of this Law.

Article 7. This Law shall be valid for only one year after its enforcement.

#### Cabinet Order No. 215

Special Measures Order for Liquidation of City, Town or Village Agricultural Association

For the purpose of enforcing the Law concerning Liquidation of the Agricultural Organization and others in consequence of the Establishment of the Agricultural Cooperative Association Law (Law No. 133 of 1947), the Cabinet hereby establishes the Cabinet Order concerning Special Measures for Liquidation of City, Town or Village Agricultural Association, based on the provisions of Article 7 of the Agricultural Organization Law (Law No. 46 of 1943) which is still effective under paragraph 2, Article 1 of the aforementioned Law.

(Leasing of Agricultural Association Property to Agricultural Cooperative Association)

Article 1. Any agricultural cooperative association, a part of whose members are concurrently the members of a city, town or village agricultural association, may, with the approval of the prefectural governor, ask the latter to negotiate for the leasing of the physical properties in its possession to such agricultural cooperative association. Request of agricultural cooperative associations to lease properties of agricultural associations in accordance with the Article must be made by September 14, 1948.

In case the negotiation referred to in the preceding paragraph fail to result in an agreement, the prefectural governor may, upon application by one or both of the negotiating parties, and after consultation with such negotiating parties, fix, the terms under which such physical properties will be leased to the agricultural cooperative association. Such terms will be enforced by order of the prefectural governor.

The extent to which the value of the assets of a city, town or village agricultural association may be leased to an agricultural cooperative association in accordance with the provisions of the two preceding paragraphs may not exceed the ratio between that portion of the value of shares held by members of the cooperative association who are concurrently the members of the former and the total value of shares held by the total membership of the former.

The value of each share mentioned in the preceding paragraph shall be computed in accordance with the Rules of the Association of the city, town or village agricultural association at the nearest time prior to the agreement of the negotiation referred to in paragraph 1 or the order referred to in paragraph 2.

(Procedures Applicable to Obligations of Agricultural Associations)

Article 2. Each city, town or village agricultural association shall, within three weeks from the effective date of this Cabinet Order, give public notice to the effect that those obligees who have an objection to the transfer of their financial claims against such agricultural association to agricultural cooperative association in accordance with the provisions of Article 5 or Article 6 of the Law concerning Liquidation of Agricultural Organizations and the like in consequence of the Enactment of the Agricultural Cooperative Association Law Chereinafter referred to as the Law) shall notify the said agricultural association of such an objection within a specified period. Each agricultural association shall also give such a notice individually to each known obligee.

The period referred to in the preceding paragraph within which a creditor must notify an agricultural association shall not be less than one month.

In case an obligee has failed to raise an objection within the specified period mentioned in paragraph 1 he shall be deemed to have agreed to the agricultural cooperative association's accepting liabilities refered to in the same paragraph.

In case an obligee has raised an objection within the specified period mentioned in paragraph 1 the agricultural association shall without delay effect performance or offer adequate security or else effect trust of adequate property with a trust company or a bank carrying on trust business, in order that such obligee may receive performance.
(Procedures for Disposal of Properties in Satisfaction of Obligation)

Article 3. A city, town or village agricultural association shall if necessary in order to effect performance or trust referred to in paragraph 4 of the preceding Article, sell its physical properties (excluding those held under the possession of the agricultural cooperative association in accordance with the contract provided for in Article 1, and those for which an application for leasing has been made pursuant to the provisions of the same paragraph of the same Article).

If the performance of liabilities or trust of adequate property in accordance with paragraph 4 of the preceding Article by means of the amount of sale of assets mentioned in the preceding paragraph is not enough to satisfy the claims filed by obligees the city, town or village agricultural association shall sell the whole or a part of the remaining assets.

Sale of assets under the preceding two paragraphs excluding those whose disposition shall be amendable to Law, Ordinance or measures of administrative authorities thereunder, shall be made in accordance with any one of the following procedures subject to the selection of the Property Disposal Board. In such a case, if the third procedure is adopted, no contract shall be concluded on the basis of prices lower than those, if any, determined by Law, Ordinance or order, permission, approval and other measures taken by the administrative authorities thereunder, (hereinafter referred to as official prices) or if no such official prices are available, prices lower than specified prices to be determined by the Property Disposal Board:

- 1. Sealed Bids
- 2. Auction
- 3. Free contract

The specified prices to be determined by the Property Disposal Board in accordance with the preceding paragraph shall be current appraised values.

Article 4. When agricultural association properties are sold through sealed bids, if in case there are two or more bidders at the highest price, an agricultural cooperative association whose membership includes a part of the membership of the agricultural association concerned is one of them, the said agricultural cooperative association shall become the successful bidder.

When agricultural association properties are sold through sealed bids, if the highest bidder is a third party other than the agricultural cooperative association whose membership includes a part of the members of the agricultural association concerned, the said agricultural cooperative association shall be given a chance to ask to purchase the pro-

perties in question from the agricultural association for the amount of the said bid. However such application must be made within five days following the opening of such sealed bids.

If the agricultural association refuses to transfer the property to the agricultural cooperative association the latter may request the prefectural governor to order the transfer of the property to the said agricultural cooperative association for the amount of the bid.

After making an investigation the prefectural governor may order the transfer of the properties concerned. The decision of the prefectural governor must be made within two weeks from the date of the filing of request to order the transfer of properties concerned.

The city, town or village agricultural association concerned shall not decide the highest bidder during the period specified in paragraph 2 or in the preceding paragraph.

The extent to which any agricultural cooperative association may purchase property of an agricultural association by paying the amount of the highest bid as authorized in paragraph 2 and/or 4 may not exceed the ratio between that portion of the value of the shares held by members of the cooperative association who are concurrently the members of the former and the total value of the shares held by the total membership of the former.

Article 5. Necessary matters relative to the sale of properties in accordance with paragraphs 2 and 3 of Article other than those stipulated in the preceding Article shall be determined by the Property Disposal Board.

(Transfer of Properties under Articles 5 and 6 of the Law)

Article 6. No application for approval under paragraph 1 of Article 5 or paragraph 1 of Article 6 of the Law shall be made until after the city, town or village agricultural association has completed procedures provided for in the preceding four Articles.

Article 7. The value of properties to be transferred under Articles 5 and 6 of the Law shall be determined on the basis of the official prices, if any, or specified prices to be determined by the Property Disposal Board where no such official prices are available.

The specified prices to be determined by the Property Disposal Board in accordance with the preceding paragraph shall be current appraised values.

The value of the properties concerned when a agricultural cooperative association receives a part of properties of the City, Town or Village agricultural association may be determined at different prices, notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding two Articles, only in the case where all members of the City, Town and Village agricultur-

al association concerned who have invested in accordance with the provisions of Article 36 of the Agricultural Organization Law have consented to it in writing and the procedures under the provisions of Article 2 have been completed to the obligee, provided that the value may not be less than their book values.

Supplementary Provision:

The present Cabinet Order shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

In accordance with the provisions of Article 11 and Article 28 of the Closed Institutions Ordinance, the Ordinance concerning the payment of stocks with respect to shares held by Closed Institutions shall be provided for as follows:

The Ordinance concerning the payment of stocks with respect to shares held by Closed Institutions

Article 1. The payment of stocks in case the call for payment of stocks has been made as regards shares held by Closed Institutions shall be subject to as provided for in this Ordinance.

Article 2. In case the call for payment of stocks has been made as regards shares held by the Closed Institution, the claim of the said call for payment of stocks shall, excluding otherwise provided for by the Minister of Finance, be paid in the 4th order prescribed by paragraph 1 of Article 4 of the Ordinance concerning the payment of liabilities

of Closed Institutions in accordance with the provisions of Article 1, Article 11, proviso of Article 18 and Article 28 of the Closed Institutions Ordinance "Imperial Ordinance No. 74 of 1947" (Prime Minister's Office, Ministries of Finance, Foreign Affairs, Commerce & Industry, Transportation, Agriculture & Forestry, Welfare and Justice Ordinance No. 4 of 1947, hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance"); provided, however, in case the call for payment of stocks has been made after the Closed Institution had begun to pay claims in the 4th or 5th order prescribed by paragraph 1 of Article 4 of the Ordinance, the claim of the said call for payment of stocks shall be paid after the claims in the said order have been paid.

The provisions of paragraph 3 of Article 4 of the Ordinance shall be apply mutatis mutandis to the case of proviso of the preceding paragraph.

In case the amount payable in accordance with the provisions of the preceding two paragraphs is insufficient to pay total amount called, tor, the Closed Institution shall pay amount called for in full as regards shares designated by the Minister of Finance.

Article 3. In case the call for payment of stocks has been made as regards shares held by the Closed Institution (excluding the call for payment of stocks in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 1 of Article 16 or paragraph 1 of Article 17 of the Enforcement Ordinance of the Enterprise Reconstruction and Reorganization Law "Imperial Ordinance No. 501 of 1946" or the provisions of Article 25-4 of the Finance Institutions Reconstruction and Reorganization Law "Law No. 39 of 1946"), if the said Closed Institution failed to pay to the claim of the call for payment of stocks by the day designated by the Minister of Finance, the said Closed Institution shall be released from the liability of payment of stocks and forfeit the right of stockholders, as regards the shares of which payment has not been made on the said day.

The shares as regards which the Closed Institution has forfeited the right of stockholders in accordance with the preceding paragraph shall revert automatically, on the day designated by the said paragraph, to the person who called for payment (hereinafter referred to as "unpaid stocks collector").

Article 4. The Closed Institution may make payment of stocks by means of offsetting notwithstanding the provisions of Article 200, paragraph 2 of the Commercial Code (Law No. 48 of 1899).

In case the Closed Institution have claim other than those which are subject to mortgage against the unpaid stocks collector, the Closed Institution may make the payment of stocks by offsetting with the said claim even before the date of payment. In this case the said claim and those of the call for payment of stocks shall be come extinct with-

in the extent of the mutually corresponding amount at the time of the manifestation of intention of making such offset.

The claim of the call for payment of stocks and other claims designated by the Minister of Finance shall not be used, notwithstanding the foregoing two paragraphs, for offset of the payment called for.

Article 5. The Closed Institution may deliver to the unpaid stocks collector securities such as national bonds, local government bonds and other securities as designated by the Minister of Finance in lieu of the payment of stocks called for. In this case the delivery of such securities shall be considered as same as making payment of stocks called for.

The appraised value of national bonds, local government bonds and other securities in the case of the preceding paragraph shall be governed by what is fixed by the Minister of Finance.

Supplementary Provision:

This Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

#### MINISTERIAL ORDINANCE

#### Ministry of Finance Ordinance No. 72

August 3, 1948

In accordance with the provisions of Art. 12, par. 2 of the law concerning non-life insurance rating organization, the matters relative to a public notice of premium rates shall be provided for as follows:

Art. 1. When a non-life insurance rating organization (hereinafter to be called a rating organization) has calculated its premium rates (viz. premium rates calculated in accordance with the provisions of Art. 2, par. 1 of the law concerning non-life insurance rating organization (Law No. 193 of 1948), hereinafter the same), the organization has to provide its principal office and subordinate offices with a schedule of the said premium rates.

Any interested person may request a rating organization perusal of the said schedule or delivery of a copy of same.

In case of the delivery in accordance with the preceding paragraph of a copy of the schedule as prescription in paragraph 1, the rating Organization may request the interested person payment of its cost.

- Art. 2. When a rating organization has calculated premium rates it shall make a public notice appear in the official gazette and ordinary daily newspapers within two weeks of its calculation on the following items:
  - Kind of insurance business concerning the said premimurates, and the subject matter of insurance;
  - 2. Date of calculation of the said premium rates:

- 3. Names of offices where the schedule of premium rates is provided:
- 4. Names of offices and location thereof where premium rates schedule is obtainable and the amount of its cost in case the payment thereof is requested in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 3 of the preceding paragraph.
- Art. 3. A rating organization shall have a section at its principal and subordinate offices to hear at any time the opinions of interested persons concerning the calculation of premium rates.
- Art. 4. A rating organization shall hold a public heaing concerning the calculation of premium rates, pursuant to the provisions of its articles of incorporation.

Supplementary Provision:

This Ministerial Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

In case the Chief of the Material Adjustment Office makes the allocation as mentioned in par. 4, he must consult with Local Allocation Councils therefor.

Next to Art. 4. par. 6, the following paragraph shall be added:

The Local Allocation Council as mentioned in the preceding paragraph shall be precided over by the Chief of the Material Adjustment Office and shall be composed of ten members consisting of personnel of the administrative offices concerned and persons assigned by him from among those representing the consumers according to the kinds of fisheries within the area under the jurisdiction of such office.

Art. 10, par. 1 shall be revised af follows:

In case any application for purchase has been filed for exchange with purchase coupons, no manufacturer or dealer shall refuse it unless he has no stock thereof on hand.

Next to Art. 10, par. 1, the following paragraph shall be added:

The application for purchase as mentioned in the preceding paragraph must be made within the limit of the controlled prices.

"The provision of the preceding paragraph" in Art. 10, par. 2 shall read "the provisions of the preceding two paragraphs".

Supplementary Provision:

The present Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

# Ministry of Transportation Ordinance No. 24

August 3, 1948

I hereby establish the Maritime Safety Official Certificate Regulations as follows:

Minister of Transportation OKADA Seiichi

Maritime Safety Official Certificate Regulations

Article 1. The Certificate to be kept by a Maritime Safety Official on his person in accordance with paragraph 2, Article 17 of the Maritime Safety Authorities Law (hereinafter called the Certificate) shall be provided for in this Ordinance.

Article 2. The standard from of the Certificate shall be as follows:

Thick paper of 8 cm by 12 cm; obverse side, light blue and reverse side, white. On the obverse side, a compass of a diameter of 1.6 cm shall be represented in the center, under which shall be written Certificate of Maritime Safety Official, while on the left lower part Maritime Safety Board shall be represented. On the reverse side shall be written the number of the Certificate, jurisdiction, post, full name and date of birth of the official certified together with the date on which the Certificate is delivered; a photograph of the said official shall be pasted and the seal of the Maritime Safety Board be impressed.

Its form shall be as set forth in Annex.

Article 3. In case it is necessary for a Maritime Safety Official to show his Certificate in carrying out his duties, he shall present this Certificate.

Article 4. The Certificate shall be handled with care that it may not be damaged or lost. In case it is damaged or lost the fact shall be forthwith reported to the chief of the office to which the said official is assigned.

Article 5. In case an official cerves the active service of for any reason the Maritime Safety Board, his Certificate shall be returned to the chief of the Office to which he was assigned.

Supplementary Provision:

This Ministerial Ordinance shall come into force from the day of its promulgation.




Certificate of Maritime Safety Official Maritime Safety Board
